



Case study - Family law

Difficult divorce - Ensuring equal division of the assets.

We acted on behalf of a client needing representation in divorce proceedings.

The client wanted equal division of the assets, however this was disputed by the other party.

The other party made transactions after the split which impacted the value of the estate to be divided, Verisona Law argued that the funds of these transactions should be put back into the estate for division.
